



Target group:

The game is intended for **fourth-grade elementary school students** to review the Slovak language curriculum from third grade.

Core mechanics:

- Teams take turns clockwise and draw a card with a task according to their square.
- Teams complete the task within the time limit.
- Correct answers allow teams to spin the roulette wheel and move forward.
- 3 bonus points = 1 joker card.
- The first team to reach the finish line wins.

Learning goals:

- Actively use new vocabulary in different contexts
- Verbally describe, explain, and express ideas clearly
- Create short stories using given words while recognizing basic grammatical categories
- Cooperate effectively and communicate within a team

Inclusivity & accessibility features:

- Team-based play supports learners with weaker language skills
- Multiple task types (visual, verbal, physical) suit different learning styles
- Joker cards reduce frustration after mistakes

Short game overview:

- Board game similar to Activity
- Teams complete language-based tasks
- Correct answers allow teams to move forward
- First team to reach the finish line wins
